## 2018-2019 Scholarship Requirements

## Deadline - March 31, 2018, No exceptions

The information provide is to be used by the 2017-2018 Houston A&M University Mothers' Club Scholarship Committee for the sole purpose of evaluating candidates for scholarships and making recommendations to the Board of Directors. Go to <a href="http://www.houstonaggiemome.aggienetwork.com">www.houstonaggiemome.aggienetwork.com</a> for an online application.

- The candidate shall be a <u>current, full-time student</u> (enrolled in at least 12 semester hours or equivalent if a graduate student) at Texas A&M University and shall be classified as a sophomore, junior, senior, or graduate student in good standing. The candidate shall have a minimum overall GPA of 2.50. Incoming freshmen are not eligible to receive a scholarship. Current freshmen students may apply for a scholarship to be used for their sophomore year. Blinn Team students with a minimum GPA of 3.0 may apply during their sophomore year to be used during their junior year at Texas A&M. \*\*
- The student's permanent residential (home) address as of September 1, 2017 must be in one of the following zip codes:

- The scholarship award is a fixed amount determined by the Board of Directors and is to be applied to normal tuition and fees.
- The applicant may not be a recipient of a current Houston A&M Mothers' Club scholarship, endowed scholarship, a 4-year academic scholarship awarded by the Office of Honors Programs or any other major scholarships awarded by Texas A&M University.
- The duration of the scholarship is for the scholastic year beginning no later than the fall semester following the award. (Onesemester seniors are the exception; they will receive their allotted scholarship for their one remaining semester.) Each scholarship recipient shall be enrolled as a full-time student in good standing at Texas A&M University for the duration of the scholarship (except during the final semester before graduation)
- IN ONE ENVELOPE, PLEASE SEND an OFFICIAL COPY OF THE APPLICANT'S LATEST TRANSCRIPT (including Fall 2017 grades from Texas A&M University, sealed in its original envelope), and a copy of the applicant's Student Schedule for the Spring 2018 semester to the address below. *IT MUST BE POSTMARKED BY THE UNITED STATES POST OFFICE ON OR BEFORE MARCH 31, 2018, OR THE APPLICATION WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR CONSIDERATION*. Before mailing, confirm there is a visible date postmarked on the envelope! (Certified mail is recommended).

No emails will be sent to notify you of receipt. Please note that all materials must be received and/or dated by March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018 to be eligible for consideration by the Houston A&M University Mother's Club for a scholarship award. Any applications received after this date will not be considered. Incomplete applications also will not be considered.
- Successful candidates will be notified of their award in early May 2018.
- The Scholarship Committee shall hold all information provided herein to be confidential.
- The candidate specifically authorizes the Houston A&M University Scholarship Committee to substantiate any data provided herein.
